

Raharney Senior Hurler Player's Charter.

The following are a set of expectations & obligations of a Raharney senior hurler, to himself, his team and the club.

1. Pays the appropriate membership fee, on time. March 31st is the GAA official deadline.
2. Gives some time to Underage Training. Anything from a couple of BallWall sessions per year to Underage team support e.g. a couple of sessions per month.
3. Gives some time & effort to a Fundraising event, at least once per year.
4. Gives some time to a volunteering effort, at least once per year: Road Litter picks, Joristown development projects etc.
5. Attends training and matches on time. Is late only in exceptional circumstances.
6. Responds to squad requests from Team Management by the deadline set e.g. availability for a specific training session or a request for specific information.
7. Looks after Club property as if it was your own e.g. Sliotars, Gym equipment, Dressing Rooms.
8. Is always respectful of other club grounds and leaves Dressing rooms, Dugouts etc as found.
9. Looks out for one another, whether in training, games, or social occasions. Older lads or anyone interested in the future of the Raharney Club: attend the December AGM.
10. To just fund Hurling for a year costs at least €500 per player! And there are additional running costs for the Club such as heating, electricity, bins, maintenance. All players are asked to contribute to the Lotto, even if only €2 per week. Play online with Clubforce.
